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Answers & explanations

1. **Answer B.** The first grid rotates one quarter turn clockwise. Rotating the second grid the same way puts orange squares in the left and right corners, with the other squares matching B.
2. **Answer A.** Every blue square becomes white, and every white square becomes blue. Applying the same color swap to the green and black pattern makes each green square black and each black square green. This gives A.
3. **Answer C.** The shirt, zebra, and barber pole are striped. The solid blue scarf is the only object without stripes, so C does not belong.
4. **Answer B.** The inner and outer shapes switch places, then the shape moved inside flips vertically. The orange trapezoid moves outside, and the black triangle moves inside and points down. This gives B.
5. **Answer B.** The first pair adds one shape and flips every shape upside down. Apply both changes to the second pair: two upward triangles become three downward triangles. This gives B.
6. **Answer B.** The pattern alternates between subtracting 3 and adding 2: 6, 3, 5, 2. The next step adds 2, making 4 beads. This gives B.
7. **Answer A.** The first pair matches an object with the sense used for it: you taste ice cream with your tongue. You smell a flower with your nose, so A completes the same relationship.
8. **Answer C.** Each fold reflects the punched hole. Unfolding across both folds creates four matching holes, one near each corner. This matches C.

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
