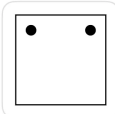
The paper is folded and hole-punched. Pick how it looks unfolded.



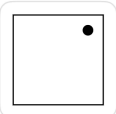




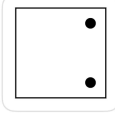

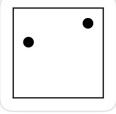

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Answers & explanations

1. A · 2. A · 3. A · 4. C · 5. A

1. **Answer A.** The first pair keeps the shape the same and moves the shading from the top half to the bottom half. Applying that rule to the square gives A.
2. **Answer A.** The first pair matches an object with the sense used for it: you taste ice cream with your tongue. You smell a flower with your nose, so A completes the same relationship.
3. **Answer A.** Both sides must total five squares. Four squares are already shown, so the missing box needs one more square. This gives A.
4. **Answer C.** The pattern adds one bead each time: one, two, three. The next rod needs four beads. This gives C.
5. **Answer A.** Unfolding reflects the punched hole across the vertical fold. This creates two holes at matching heights on opposite sides. That pattern appears in A.

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
