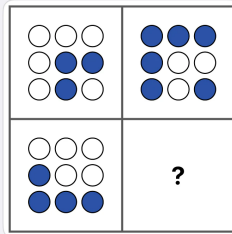

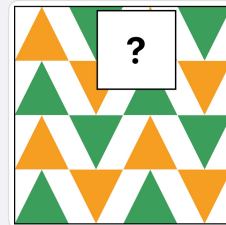

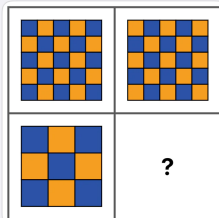

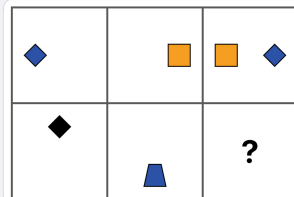

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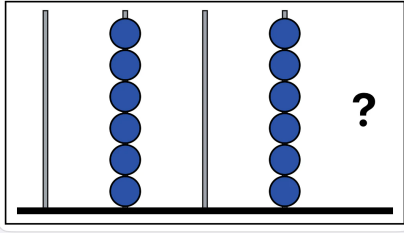

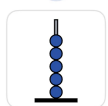

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Answers & explanations

1. B · 2. C · 3. A · 4. A · 5. C · 6. A

1. **Answer B.** Every filled circle becomes empty, and every empty circle becomes filled. Applying that same reversal to the second pattern gives B.
2. **Answer C.** The triangle edges and colors must continue across the missing space without a break. Only C completes every line and preserves the orange, green, and white pattern.
3. **Answer A.** The first pair swaps every blue square with an orange square. Applying the same color swap to the smaller checkerboard creates the pattern in A.
4. **Answer A.** The first pair combines the two shapes and switches their positions. Applying that rule below places the blue trapezoid above the black diamond. This gives A.
5. **Answer C.** The rods alternate between empty and six beads: empty, six, empty, six. The next rod must be empty. This gives C.
6. **Answer A.** The first pair matches an object with the sense used for it: you taste ice cream with your tongue. You smell a flower with your nose, so A completes the same relationship.

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
